However, at the Cancer Fund we continued to provide much needed FREE professional support. We have helped raise awareness on the importance of detecting cancer early to save lives. We offered psychosocial support for anyone touched by cancer and have celebrated with so many cancer survivors.



At the Cancer Fund we bring together so many amazing people from all walks of life, including survivors and their families, corporations, schools, foundations, donors and many more.

Thanks to our professional frontline team of social workers, dietitians, oncology nurses, clinical psychologist, counsellors and art therapists we had nearly 50,000 attendances to our four Cancer Support Centres in the last year.

I am so grateful for the 21 Self-Help Groups that continue to expand year-on-year with nearly 16,000 members. They have provided peer support to so many individuals who share the same type of cancer.

The demand for our wellness programmes continues to increase, they incorporate 11 types of mindfulness-based programmes which help our clients to understand the deep connection between body and mind and cultivate a state of inner peace and joy that promotes self-healing and enhances the quality of life. Our 530 programmes provided 1,324 sessions and had an attendance of nearly 22,500.

I am truly grateful for our entire team who ensured that anyone touched by cancer did not feel alone and that we have been there regardless of external and global forces. A cancer diagnosis affects the entire family and with your support the Cancer Fund has been able to provide much needed FREE professional care.

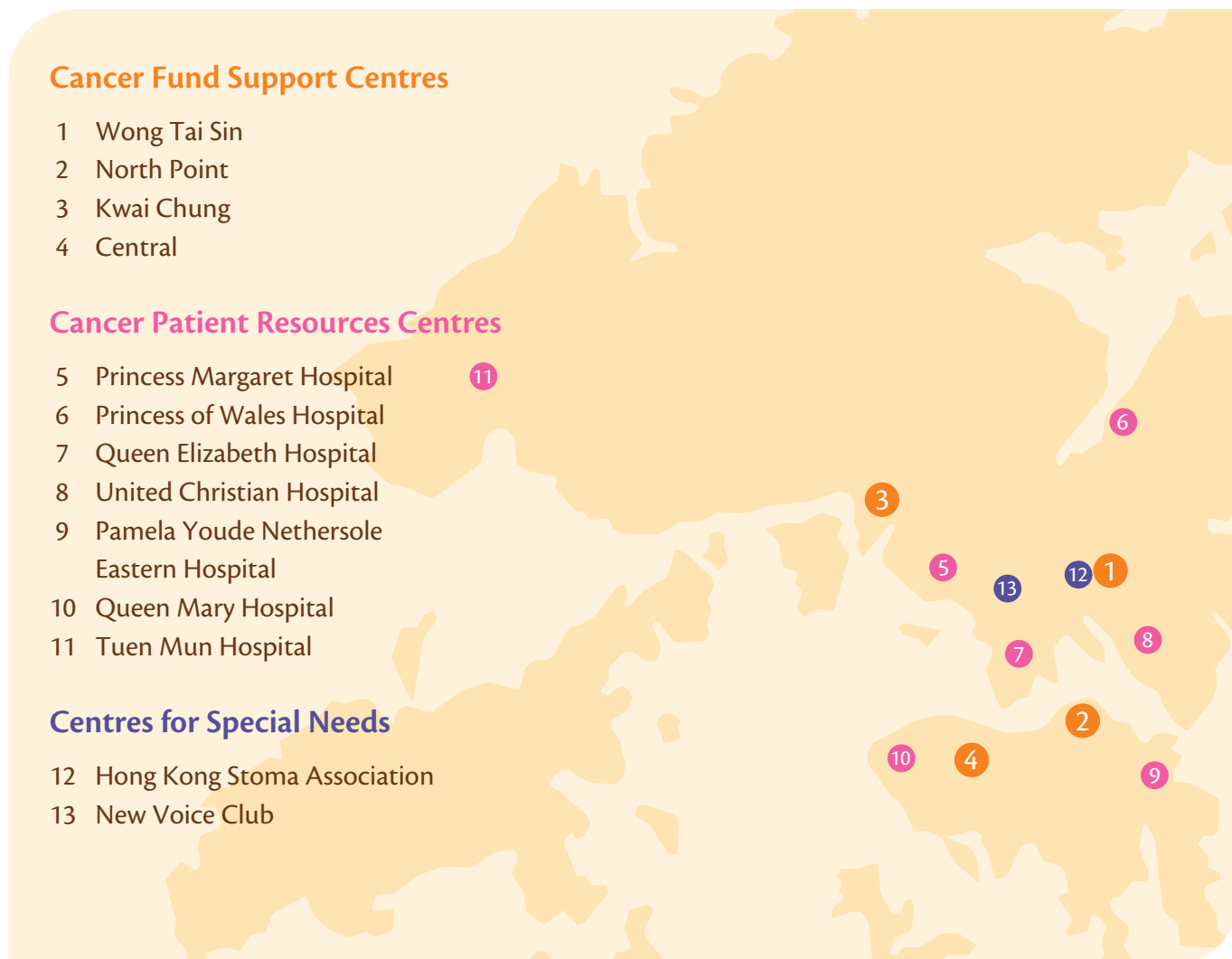

Helping People in Need

We provide FREE information, professional guidance and peer support to anyone living with, or touched by cancer. With a network of support spanning the hospital, the community and home, our mission is to ensure that no one faces cancer alone. We provide tailored services such as psycho-social care and wellness classes, oncology nursing consultations, art therapy, relief fund assistance, dietetic advice, counselling, social work support and so much more.

Every year the number of people being diagnosed with cancer is on the increase and our Cancer Support Centres are facing even more demand as more and more people are living with cancer.

During the first 6 months of this fiscal year Hong Kong was still dealing with COVID restrictions. As we moved into the second half of the year we saw an increase in demand for our services as social distancing laws were relaxed.

49,085 Attendances Recorded at our 4 Cancer Support Centres

Our 4 Cancer Support Centres are located in Kwai Chung, Wong Tai Sin, North Point and Central. We are there for anyone touched by cancer to drop in, join a class or programme or speak with one of our many professional front line teams. We are open from Monday to Saturday from 9.00am to 6.00pm.

The oncology nurses at our Support Centres play a key part in ensuring every cancer patient is well informed about their own specific cancer, its treatments and expected side effects. They also contribute to monitoring the physical and psychosocial symptoms and problems, whilst providing emotional support and guidance to the whole family. We provided 1,011 programmes for 12,342 clients across 1,911 sessions.

Some of our clients need advice on symptom management and nutritional requirements at each stage of treatment and recovery. Our caring professional teams are available to help with one-on-one consultations providing them with the personalised care and support that they need.

The Cancer Fund Helpline is on call to offer immediate support and professional information about cancer to the public. The Helpline team will refer clients to our professionally trained social workers and oncology nurses for them to provide the latest information, referral to cancer support services, and alleviate anxieties through emotional support.



1,360 Parents and Children in our Rainbow Club

Cancer affects the entire family especially children, who are often overlooked when a parent or close family member has cancer. Our professional team provides each child, aged 5-17 years old, with a tailor-made healing therapy programme. Our specialists combine several techniques to provide the most appropriate support for the children in need, helping them express their inner emotions or hidden feelings, guiding them to understand the cancer journey of their family member, and assisting them to build resilience to cope with the changes brought by cancer. We helped 714 children and 646 parents over 48 programmes with 1,000 sessions.

671 Volunteers

At the Cancer Fund we understand the importance of the valuable help that our volunteers provide. Most of our amazing team have experienced cancer first hand and have used our free professional services during their own cancer journey and would now like to support others on the road to recover. Our group of volunteers participated in 8 types of volunteer service activities with 1,730 sessions and 12,619 attendances.

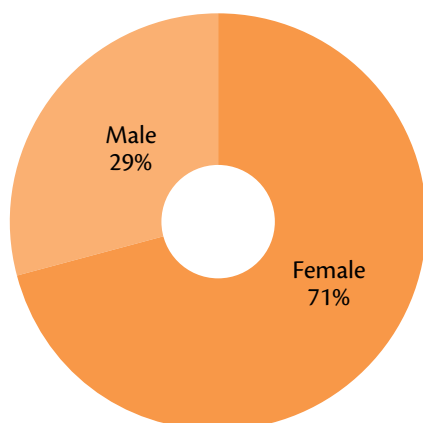
15,679 Friends of Cancer Fund, Peer Support Group

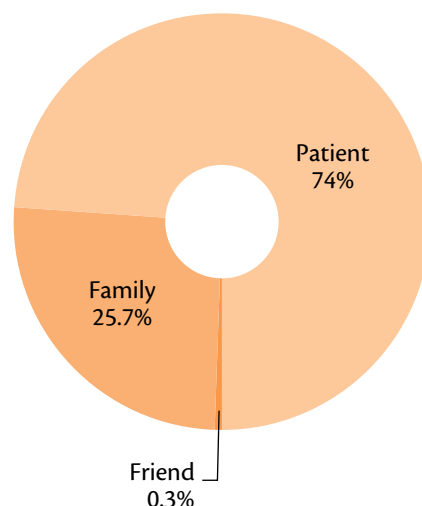
Who We Are Supporting

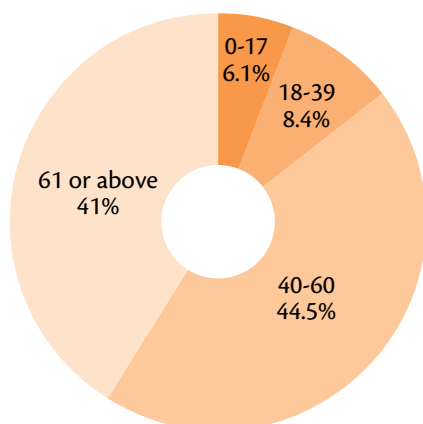

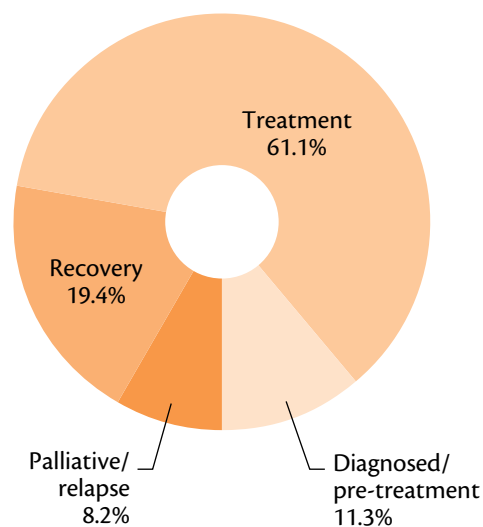

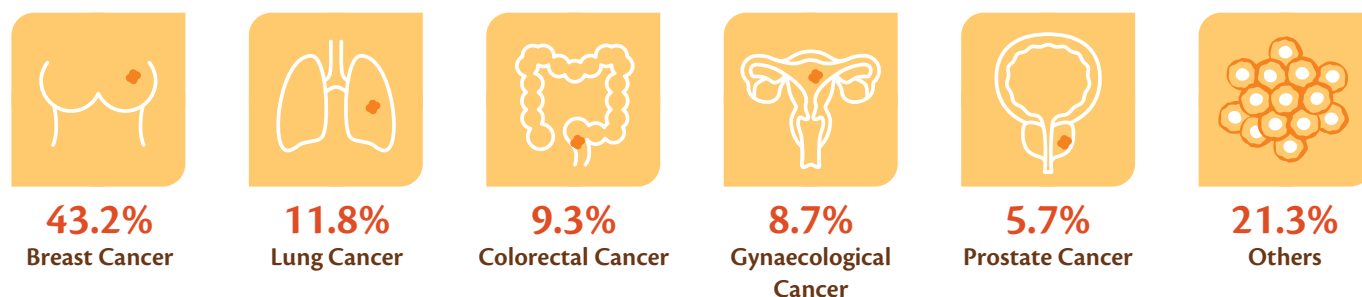
Age Group

Raising Awareness

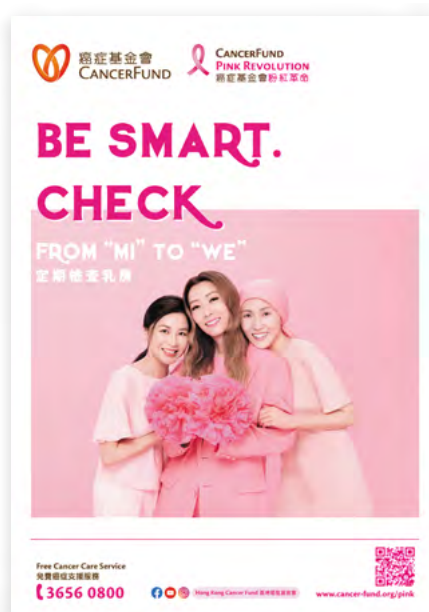
Every year nearly 35,000 people are diagnosed with cancer in Hong Kong. Knowing more about cancer is important in building a healthy and cancer aware city. The Cancer Fund educates the public on how to lower cancer risk and also the importance of regularly checking for life-saving early diagnosis.

In this fiscal year we ran 3 education campaigns for Colorectal Cancer, Breast Cancer and Prostate Cancer and one service campaign for our Rainbow Club.

Our Breast Cancer Campaign Kick-Off Event is Back!



We were thrilled that social distancing guidelines were eased in time for us to hold our Pink Revolution kick-off event at Festival Walk. Sammi Cheng was joined on stage by breast cancer survivor Ms Kwok and Dr Janice Tsang and other breast cancer survivors. We had over 80 guests including sponsors, volunteers and members of the public enjoying the afternoon with us.

Service Campaign – Rainbow Club

To help raise awareness of our Rainbow Club we ran a dedicated campaign in March and April 2023. We hosted a Rainbow Club experience day and arranged a media interview with a Rainbow Club family to share how the Cancer Fund helped them when cancer came to their family. The media coverage was well received with a PR value of HK\$1.2 million.






Publications: Cancer Booklets



This year we once again expanded our distribution network for our cancer educational booklets and these can now be found in 41 outlets including public and private hospitals, clinics, district health centres and community centres. We revised and digitalised 6 booklets this year; Bladder Cancer, Prostate Cancer, Colorectal Cancer, Breast Cancer, Ovarian Cancer and Cancer and Diet.

Pink Revolution

Pink Revolution is our annual call to action for raising breast cancer awareness and funds to support our FREE breast cancer services. We raised HK\$2,768,994 with over 100 organisations and more than 3,500 participants supporting our Dress Pink Day on Friday 21st October 2022 and our month long Shop for Pink event.

Stride for a Cure

As government restrictions were still in place we once again held a virtual Stride for a Cure. We encouraged participants to walk any time in November to December and had 545 registrations including cancer survivors from our peer support groups, individuals, families, groups, corporates and hospitals. In total we raised a total of HK\$1,610,321.

Fine Arts Asia

Fine Arts Asia was back again on 4-8 October 2022. It is recognised as one of the most distinguished fine art fairs in the region, displaying museum-quality Asian and Western antiques, modern and contemporary art. Twenty two talented artists donated their remarkable artworks for our charity auction and we raised HK\$645,700 for our free cancer care services.



Ralph Lauren Pink Pony Campaign

A huge thank you to Ralph Lauren! For more than two decades Ralph Lauren has been dedicated to cancer care and prevention with its global philanthropic Pink Pony campaign. This year they donated one hundred percent of the purchase price from the Pink Pony Oxford Shirt and Pink Pony Fleece Hoodie and a percentage of the sales from other classics in the pink colourway. This year they raised a staggering HK\$581,675 to support Cancer Fund's Pink Revolution.



Legal Walk

The Hong Kong Legal Walk kicked off its inaugural walk from 15th October to 12th November 2022. Participants were encouraged to choose a level that they would like to walk, these included 'Walkers' who were encouraged to walk from Taikoo Place to Central Harbourfront Wheel (7.5km), the 'Trekker' suggested from Aldrich Bay to Kennedy Town (12.5km) and the ultimate 'Challenger' was the Hong Kong Island Coastal Trail (25+kms). They raised a staggering HK\$1m and HK Cancer Fund was one of the chosen charities, receiving HK\$252,353. Thank you to the event organisers and all of the participants for taking part!



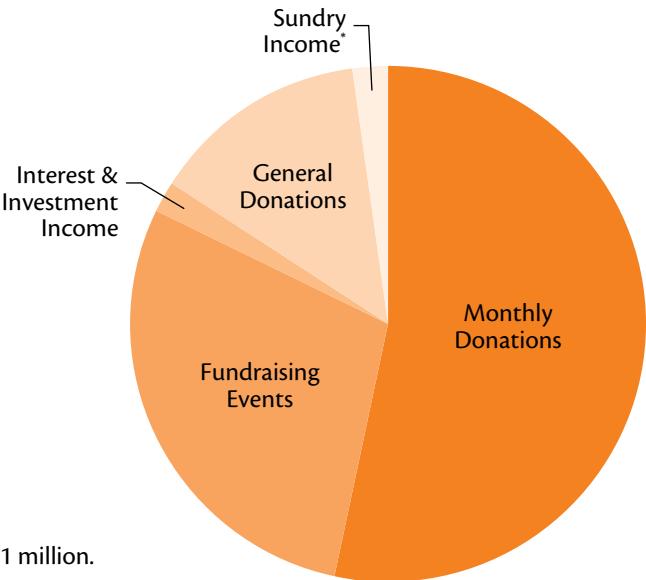
Movember

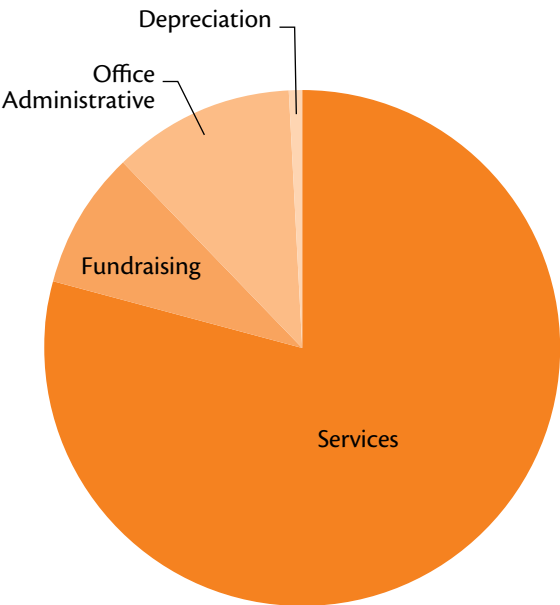

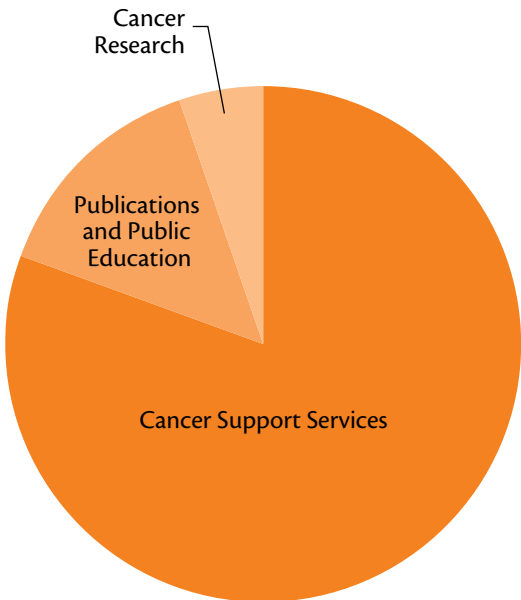
Total Expenditure HK\$83,565,673

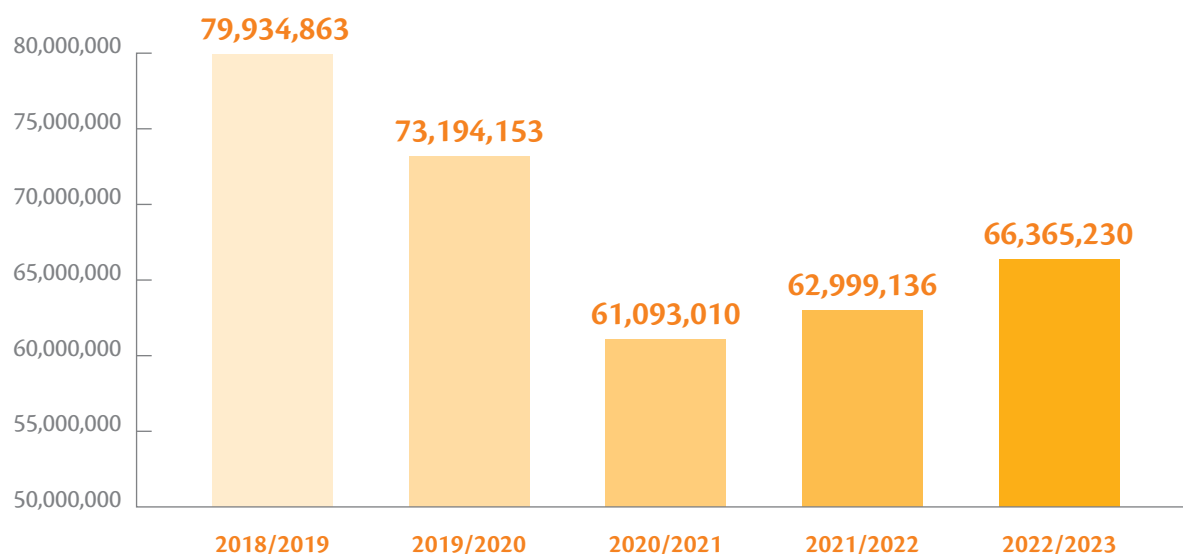
Total Expenditure HK\$66,365,230

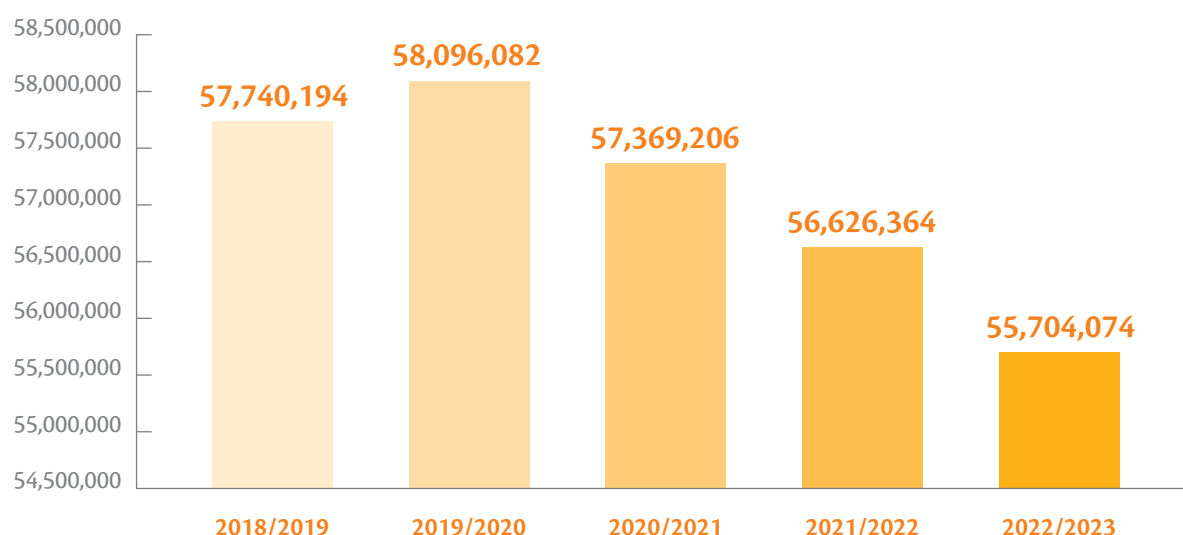
Services: 5-Year Development
