At Hong Kong Cancer Fund, we support individuals and families through every step of their cancer journey. From emotional and practical support to nursing care, counselling, and wellness programmes, our aim is to ease the challenges of cancer with compassion and expert care. Last year, nearly 32,000 cancer patients and their families came to us for support.

We are incredibly proud of our dedicated team of professional caregivers, our social workers, counsellors, oncology nurses, dietitian, clinical psychologist and wellness experts, they deliver their care with empathy, expertise and tireless commitment. Thanks to them, our Cancer Support Centres are warm, welcoming spaces of healing and hope.

Over the year, we offered more than 2,000 wellness sessions through 500+ programmes, averaging 40 sessions each week. These classes help reduce stress, support recovery and improve quality of life for those touched by cancer. While many returned to join our in-person classes, we also continued to offer live-streamed sessions, ensuring that support remained flexible and accessible.

We are also delighted to share that PURE International has generously partnered with us once again, offering their facilities and professional yoga instructors to help us expand our wellness services starting April 2025. We are truly grateful for their amazing support.

To every person who makes our work possible, a huge thank you. Together, we are making sure that no one faces cancer alone.

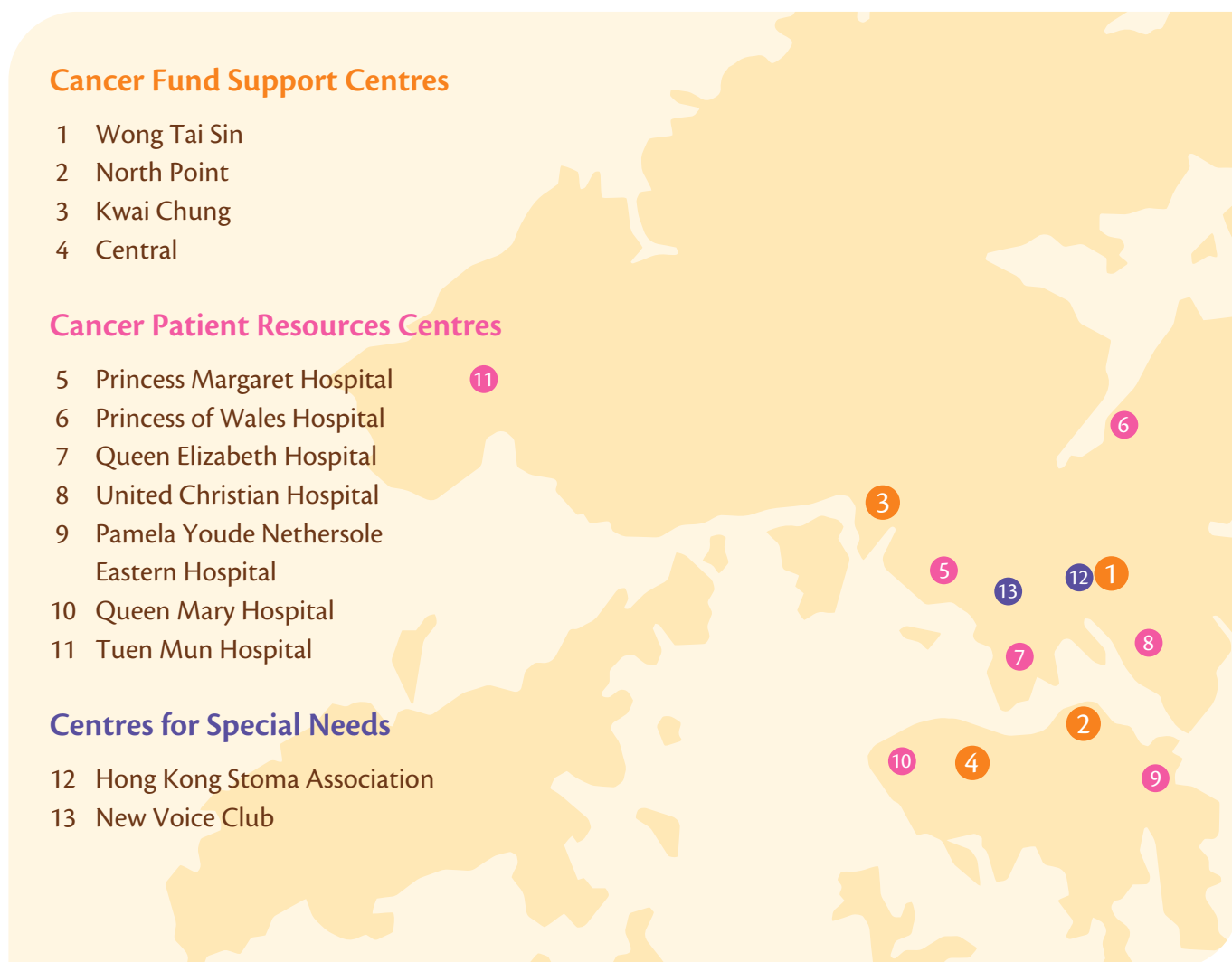

Here Every Step of the Way

Hong Kong Cancer Fund provides **FREE** professional cancer support to anyone touched by cancer, whether you're a patient, survivor, carer, or family member. Our services extend beyond the hospital, reaching deep into the community and into people's homes, to ensure holistic care is always within reach. With a focus on emotional, physical, and practical wellbeing, we provide personalised support through our four Cancer Support Centres. These include counselling, oncology nursing advice, dietetic guidance, therapeutic activities, wellness classes, financial assistance, and social work services, all designed to ease the challenges of cancer and fill the critical gaps in care.

Cancer continues to touch more people across Hong Kong, with 35,373* new cases diagnosed last year alone, that's an average of nearly 97 people every day! We are seeing increasing demand for our **FREE** services month by month, and it's clear that many more in our community still need the care and comfort we provide.

44,094 Attendances Recorded at our 4 Cancer Support Centres

Our four Cancer Support Centres welcomed over 44,000 visits last year, showing just how many people rely on us for comfort, connection, and practical support throughout their cancer journey. Each visit reminds us of the trust and hope people find in our centres, where professional care and kindness are always ready and waiting.



8,179 One-off Consultations

Last year, we provided 8,179 one-off consultations, offering personalised and in-depth guidance tailored to each individual's unique needs. Whether it's support from a nurse, advice from a dietitian, or counselling to help manage emotions, these consultations give people the confidence and care they need to face their cancer journey. They're meaningful moments where we provide expert professional advice and practical support, making a real difference when it matters most.

1,129 Nursing and Psychosocial Therapeutic Programmes

Our oncology nursing care focuses on supporting both the emotional and physical wellbeing of anyone touched by cancer. We ensure each patient is well informed about their specific cancer, treatments, and possible side effects, helping them feel more prepared and confident. Through compassionate, personalised care, we create a safe and nurturing space where individuals can find relief, build resilience, and connect with others who truly understand their journey. This dedicated support empowers people to face the challenges of cancer with greater strength and hope.



5,323 Helpline Calls

Our helpline handled over 5,300 calls last year, providing timely support and reliable information to those touched by cancer. Whether answering questions or offering guidance, our trained team is dedicated to helping people feel supported and better informed every time they reach out.



2,427 Rainbow Club members

Our Rainbow Club, a special community for children and young people affected by cancer, now has 2,427 children and parents. It provides a safe and nurturing environment where young members receive emotional support, enjoy fun and creative. It also offers support and resources for parents, helping families navigate this challenging journey together with greater strength and hope.



16,336 Friends of CancerFund

Our network of 22 self-help peer support groups, known as Friends of CancerFund, now includes 16,336 members. These groups connect people affected by the same type of cancer, providing a welcoming space to share experiences, offer mutual encouragement, and build lasting bonds. We proudly fund and support these groups, helping them provide a safe and understanding community where members can share, learn, and grow together.



679 Volunteers

Last year, 679 dedicated volunteers generously gave their time and skills to support our work. They helped with everything from administration and centre ambassador roles to caring calls, programme support, peer matching, enrolment, hospital assistance, and professional services. They play a vital part in making sure our community receives the care and support it needs.

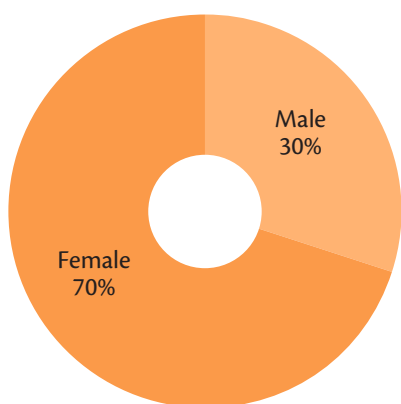

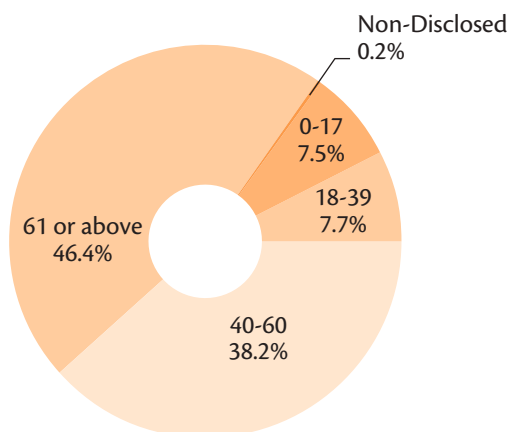

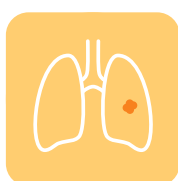

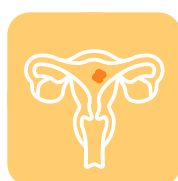

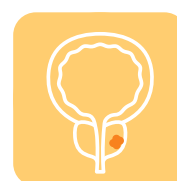

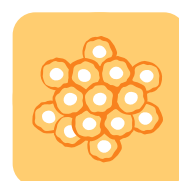

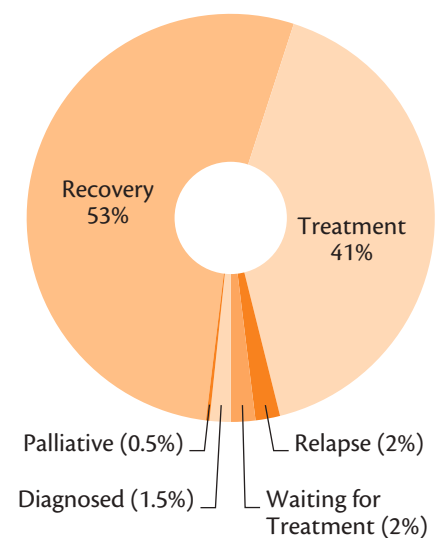

Art from Hearts

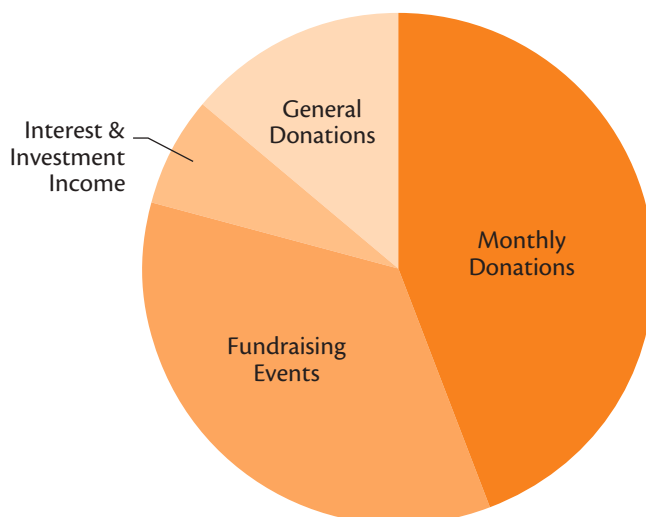

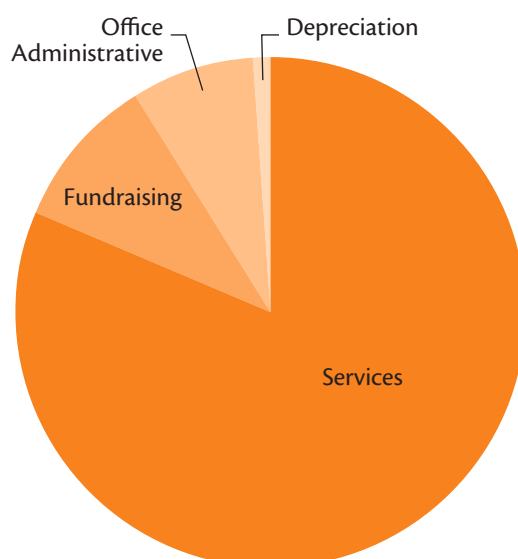
Total Income **HK\$121,805,698**

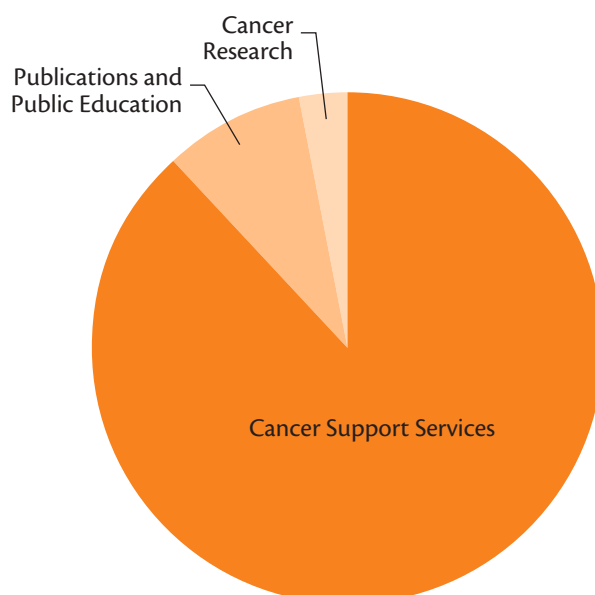
Total Expenditure **HK\$97,663,911**

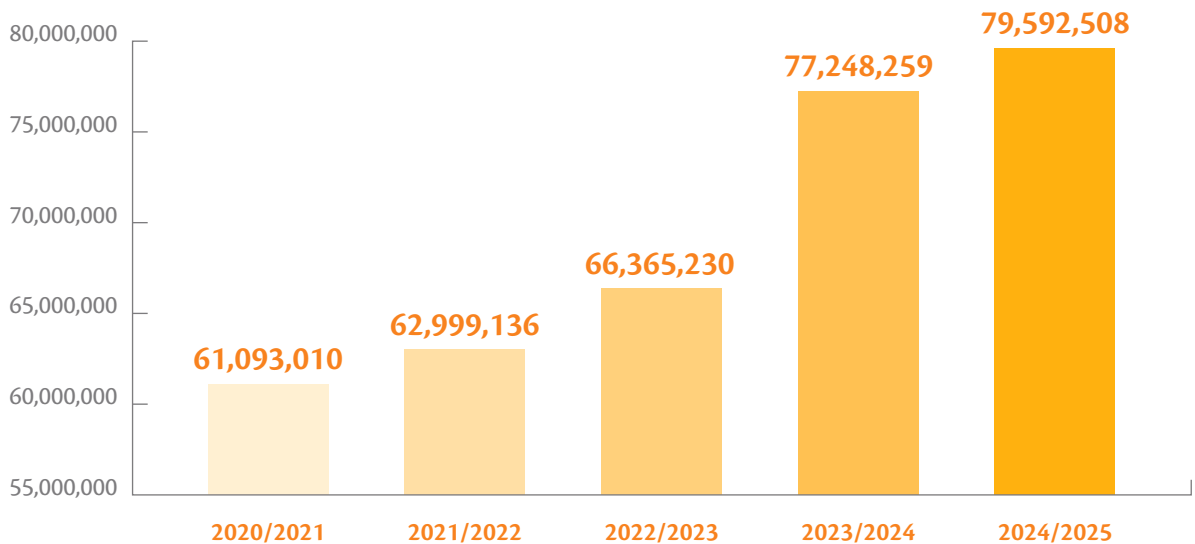
Total Expenditure **HK\$79,592,508**

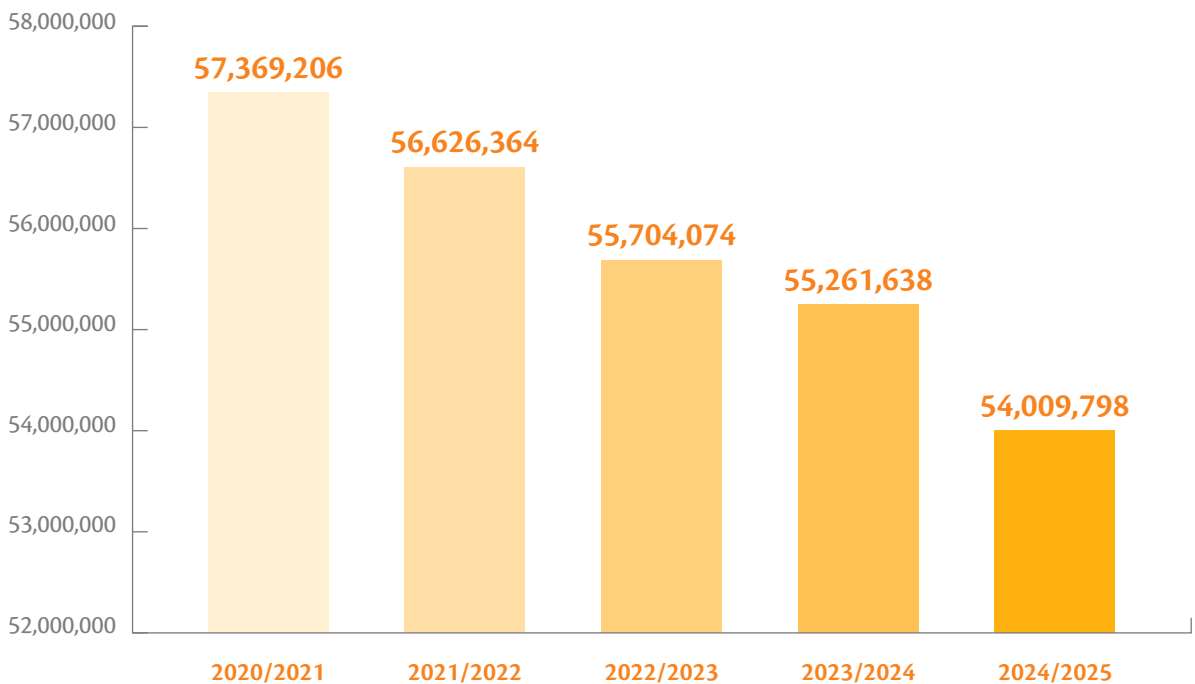
Services: 5-Year Development
